

This bilingual haiku collection is a homageto Tsureure-gusa (lit., "idle essays") by Yoshida Kenkō (1283–1352; generally known as "Kenkō-hōshi" [Monk Kenkō]; his real surname was most likely Urabe). The 243 essays written by this hermitlike monk in Kyoto in the mid-14th century are characterized by witty anecdotes and wise aphorisms, as well as by deep

insight and observations of life and nature. Tsureure-gusa is considered one of The Three Great Essays in Japanese classic literature.

This haiku collection (2022) presents original haikus by this author, inspired by Kenkō-hōshi's essays. Part III includes 81 essays by Kenkō-hōshi–from Essay 163 to Essay 243–in the order in which he compiled them and introduces 89 original haikus by this author, with annotations.

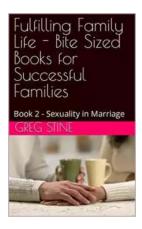

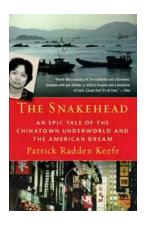
